- *last day to submit slides to be juried April 6, 2022*
- *Artists will be notified if accepted by April 11, 2022*
- *Work needs to be delivered to New Deal Gallery & Studio by Saturday April 20, 2022*
- *Artwork needs to be picked up after the exhibit. Let us know if your work is for sale. Gallery will take 20%*
